Baggage claim

Baggage Claim will be available to participants only to drop off items to obtain after the race. Bags are not to exceed 18x18in.

Participants must leave their name tag on their bag.

Baggage claim items must be picked up prior to the last heat time cap, 5:00pm.

The Town of Payson or the Baggage Claim sponsor are not liable for any items. We recommend you do not leave high value items in your car or bags.

Gladiator challenge

The following will qualify to compete in the Gladiator Challenge:

Top 8 times from the Men's Elite Heat (7:20am/7:30am)

Top 8 times from the Women's Elite Heat (7:45am/7:55am)

Top 4 from Hero Heat 1 & Hero Heat 2 (7:00/7:10am)

Top 2 from Male Teen Elite Heat (8:05am)

Top 2 from Female Teen Elite Heat (8:15am)

Top 2 from Male Masters Elite Heat (8:30am)

Top 2 from Female Masters Elite Heat (8:40am)

*The Town of Payson reserves the right to permit or deny participants outside the top 8, 4 or top 2 to participate in the Gladiator Challenge.

Gladiator challenge

Participants will advance through the Gladiator Challenge based on time per round, through the Coliseum obstacles. Only head to head matchup in the final round.

(3 rounds) Elite Male & Female | 8 participants – 4 participants – 2 participants

(2 rounds) Hero | 4 participants – 2 participants

(1 round) Teen & Masters

Elite/specialty heats

Male & Female Elite Heats – only men and women are to participate in their respective gender heat. Top 8 male and top 8 female times will qualify for the Gladiator Challenge; only registered participants in the Elite Male & Elite Female heats will be considered.

Teen Elite - only men and women are to participate in their respective gender heat. Must be 12-17 years of age the day of the race to qualify within this heat; only registered participants in the Elite Male Teen & Elite Teen Female heats will be considered.

Masters Elite - only men and women are to participate in their respective gender heat. Must be 50+ years of age the day of the race to qualify within this heat; only registered participants in the Elite Male Masters & Elite Masters Female heats will be considered.

Hero – both heats offered are co-ed heats. The top 2 times in both heats will qualify to participate in the Gladiator Challenge. Must have served or are currently serving within Law, Fire, Military, Medical, EMS, or other qualifying category to participate in this heat.

Gladiator challenge prizes

Men's Elite – Top 3 will receive Gladiator Medals, 1st place will receive \$1,000

Women's Elite – Top 3 will receive Gladiator Medals, 1st place will receive \$1,000

Hero Heat – Top 2 will receive Gladiator Medals, 1st place will receive \$100 and honorary traveling helmet trophy

Male Teen – Top 2 will receive Gladiator Medals, 1st place will receive \$50

Female Teen – Top 2 place will receive Gladiator Medals, 1st place will receive \$50

Male Masters – Top 2 will receive Gladiator Medals, 1st place will receive \$50

Female Masters – Top 2 will receive Gladiator Medals, 1st place will receive \$50

Ages

Mogollon Monster Mudda Participants must be 12 years of age and up the day of the race, no exceptions.

All Kidz Mudda participants must be 6-11 years of age the day of the race. Kidz Mudda participants must run in their respective age heats. **Kidz Mudda participants are not permitted to run the Mogollon Monster Mudda.**

Any participant under the age of 18 must have a parent/guardians signature accompanying registration prior to participation.

Race timing

Race timing will be done by CEP Timing.

Timing chips are MYLAPS Multi-Sport Disposable Chips, which are in the form of an ankle strap. The ankle strap number will act as your bib.

The disposable chips are to be worn by each entrant to ensure proper timing. Chips must be securely wrapped around the ankle. DO NOT duct tape over the strap number to avoid interference with the chip.

“Chip Timed” race means your time will begin when you cross the start line; not total heat start time.

Race results will be on-site at the finish line, posted on paysonrimcountry.com/mudda, and ceptiming.com

CEP Timing results are final.

If a chip timer malfunctions, time may not be recorded for that individual.

Teams

Registration will not allow groups to register as teams, but with all heats open you can select a heat to participate in together; as long as space permits.

If you want to reserve a heat or slots within a heat, payment for those slots must be paid upfront. If slots are not filled, no refunds will be given.

If you want to run in multiple heats, you will be charged per heat and will be issued different ankle timers per heat.

****Once registered, no refunds or credits.**

Registration prices

Throughout registration for the Mogollon Monster Mudda, prices will increase and discounts will be offered. At the time of your registration, you will be charged the current rate. Additional cost for day-of registration, if space permits.

Kidz Mudda will be \$25 throughout registration, and remain \$25 the day-of (cash only, if space permits).

Cash is the **ONLY** method of payment for day-of registration. Check or credit card will not be accepted.

Heat swap/change

Any heat time changes must be done prior to May 1, 2020. Any request to change heat times after May 1, 2020 will be denied.

No transfers of registration/person to person.

Any requests for transfer of heat time must be done by May 14, 2021 by 4:00PM after this deadline all other requests will be denied. Only available to transfer to a heat time that is not full.

Gender

Gender will be determined as what is represented on your current, valid state driver's license or state ID.

photos

Only approved photographers are allowed to be on the course!

Approved photographers: Have written permission from the Town of Payson Parks, Recreation & Tourism Office. Approved photographers will have credential verification.

Non-approved photographers on the course will be escorted off the property.

Photos will be available free of charge to participants via Adventure Payson Facebook Page (@AdventurePayson). Allow 3-5 business days after the race for all photos to be uploaded.

Water/first aid stations

Water stations will be throughout the course, and specified on the official race map.

Minor first aid will be available water stations.

EMS Services will be available on-site, if needed.

STAY HYDRATED!! Pre-hydrate for this event, and bring water!!

Spectators

Spectators must practice social distancing and follow all current COVID-19 implemented.

Spectators cannot participate in any portion of the race. All spectators are asked to stay clear of the racecourse for their safety, as well as participants'. Spectators will need to follow all instructions from race staff and volunteers to ensure no hindrance to the race process.

All children need to be supervised by an adult at all times.

Children are not permitted to be in the bleachers unsupervised while parent/guardians participate in the event.

strollers

Within the Payson Multi-Event Center (main arena) there are pathways for ease of strollers and wheelchairs. Seating in the bleachers are also equipped for handicap seating.

Outside the Payson Multi-Event Center the footing is gravel and dirt.

No strollers or wheel chairs will be permitted to participate in the race for safety of participant(s).

obstacles

There will be water obstacles on the course that may cause submersion. If uncomfortable in the water or with your water skills, we ask you do not participate in the obstacle and complete your 10 burpees before going on the next obstacle.

There will be climbing and jumping obstacles, if you are uncomfortable in completing any of the obstacles, we ask you do not participate in the obstacle and complete your 10 burpees before going on the next obstacle.

*Any individuals in the Men's & Women's Elite Heat must complete all obstacles to qualify for the Gladiator Challenge.

Animals

Although we love pets and animals, due to the safety of all animals, spectators, competitors, staff and volunteers, dogs of any kind or any animals will not be permitted to participate in the Mogollon Monster Mudda, Kidz Mudda or Gladiator Challenge. They are invited as spectators, if well behaved, on a leash, and with the owner at all times, but cannot participate.

Remember! Its summer time, make sure your fur-friend has water too!

The Town of Payson reserves the right to remove any animal from the race facility.

Inclement weather

This is a rain or shine event, with the possibility of delay if lightening or course maintenance is required. The Town of Payson does retain the right to cancel, shorten or alter the racecourse due to weather, safety or other acts of God, or for any reason.

In the case of delays or alterations, no refunds will be given.

Due to the nature of extensive planning and pre-event expenses, if the race is cancelled no refunds will be provided to participants, vendors or sponsors.

The Town of Payson reserves the right to change the venue and/or date of the event for any reason to ensure a safe and proper race experience. In such events of change, all participants' registrations will still be valid for the new location and/or date.

The Town of Payson has the right to remove any athlete, spectator, subcontractor, vendors, or anyone else from the event, without refund, should their behavior endanger the safety of themselves/others or negatively affect the race environment, staff, venue, and property of any kind.

The Town of Payson does reserve the right to authorize other forms of refunds or deferments at their discretion under extraordinary circumstances.

What to bring

- A copy of your valid driver's license/photo ID
- Running Shoes (that you don't worry about getting a "little" muddy)
- Change of clothes & footwear for post-race
- Towel

What not to bring

- No Grilling/Fire pits
- A Bad Attitude – Enjoy Race Day!!!!

Course time limit - last heat

All Mogollon Monster Mudda participants must complete the course by 2.5 hours after the last heat is released. *All participants must complete course based on last heat time on race day.*

This course is 3+ miles. With the obstacles and elements, it would be best to add around 30 minutes to your average 5K time for an estimated finish time.
